

## AMERICAN GUILD of ORGANISTS

GUIDELINES FOR DISBANDMENT OF AN AGO CHAPTER UNDER BYLAWS, ARTICLE VII, SECTION 7. These Guidelines should be communicated to any Chapter seeking Disbandment.

Chapters are disbanded by National Council upon written request of the Chapter or by recommendation of the Regional Councillor.

Reasons for or against the disbandment may be given in writing by a committee of officers and members of the Chapter

The Chapter should pay and satisfy all liabilities and expenses prior to seeking disbandment. As indicated in the AGO National Bylaws, all remaining funds become the property of AGO National, and a check for such funds should be sent to AGO headquarters.

National Council disbands the Chapter, in writing, on a date certain, communicated to the Chapter in writing. All assets remaining on and/or after that date are the assets and property of the AGO and may be disposed of by National Council for the "non-profit purposes of the Guild."
