POE Information

Enrollment requirements

POE is designed for teenagers, ages 13-18, who have achieved an intermediate level of keyboard proficiency. Previous organ study is not required. The POE committee may choose to grant special consideration on an individual basis for admission of a potential applicant whose age or training is different from the guidelines. Registration is limited to 30 students.

Registration fee: \$450

Early Registration fee: \$425 through April 25

Registration deadline: May 30

(no registrations accepted after that date)

All cancellations received before May 30 will be refunded. All cancellations after May 30 will require a \$50 cancellation fee. No refunds for cancellation will be made after June 10.

Registration fee includes all instruction, housing, meals, transportation for all POE events, admission to special events, class materials, lesson book, POE T-shirt, and a one-year Student Membership in the American Guild of Organists. The cost of transportation to and from Wilmington, Delaware is the student's responsibility. Transportation to and from the train station and airport will be provided for students arriving by train or plane.

Housing will be at the Jesus House Retreat Center, Wilmington, in air-conditioned, double, triple, or quadruple-occupancy dorm rooms. All meals will be provided. There will be full-time supervision by POE staff.

Scholarship assistance is available through the American Guild of Organists. Contact Delaware POE Co-Director, Neil Harmon. For additional scholarship assistance, the POE committee suggests students contact their local AGO Chapters and religious institutions.
