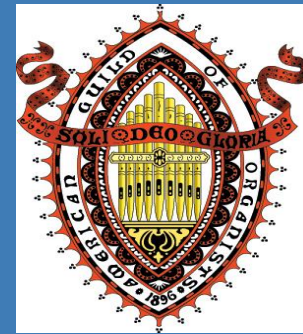

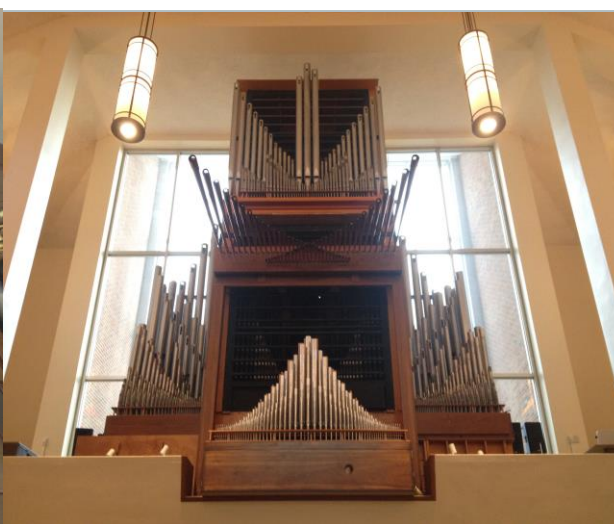
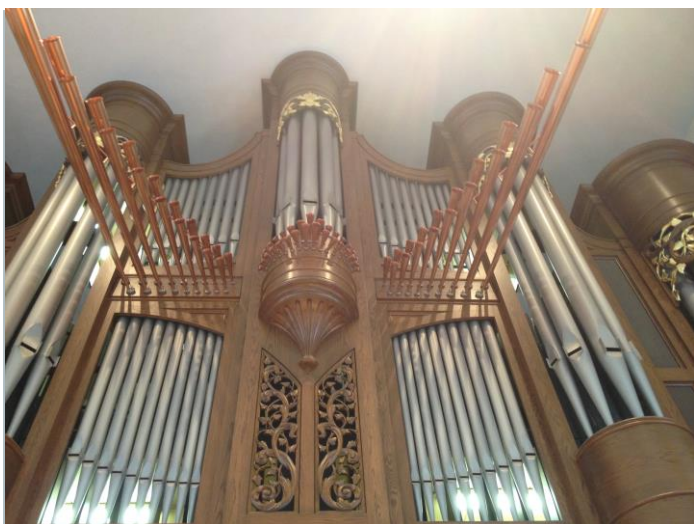

Pipe Organ Encounter Tech 2017

Overview

POE Technical is a program designed for students who are interested in learning the art and craft of organ building.

This program is for students aged 16-23, who are not required to have studied the organ. Students may possess or be seeking expertise in woodworking, electrical skills and construction. Anticipated or current collegiate study may be in the areas of liberal arts with emphasis in science and engineering.

The POE Tech will include a 4-5 day course in the history, design, construction and maintenance of the pipe organ. Classes will include study of the work of various builders, pipe making, voicing chest building and tonal design. Opportunities to play and explore a variety of instruments and attend pipe organ concerts are also offered.
