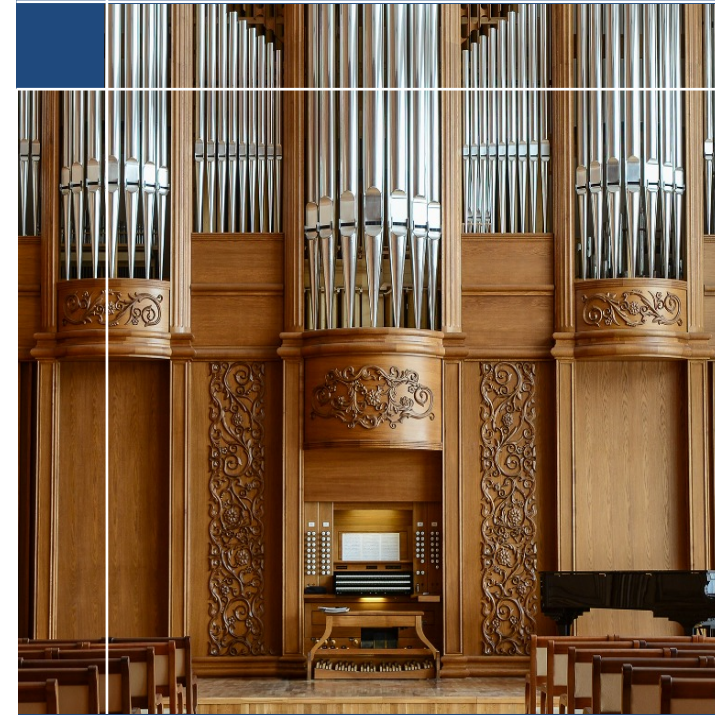

## Overview

POE is designed for teenagers, ages 13-18, who have achieved an intermediate level of keyboard proficiency. Previous organ study is not required. Special consideration with regards to age and training may be allowed by the POE Committee on an individual basis.

## POE Highlights

The Long Beach POE will include daily organ lessons (one teacher for every two participants), workshops, and a final participant recital. Other activities will include daily recitals by accomplished organists and field trips (e.g., Long Beach Aquarium). Topics to be covered may include the Alexander Technique, Hymn Playing, Organ Registration, and Organ Building.
