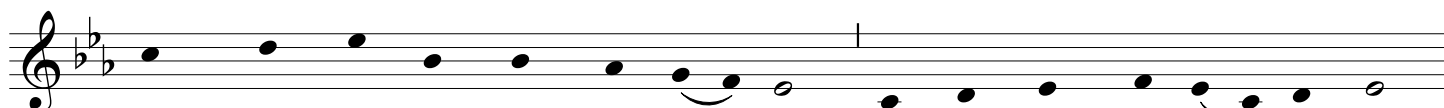

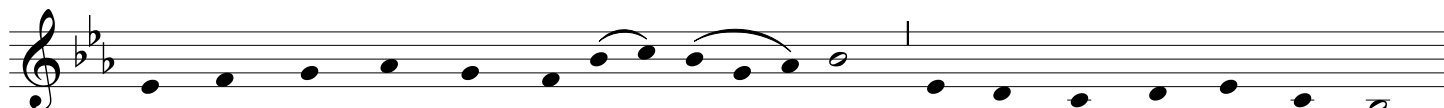
Divinum mysterium
