Preparing for the Job Interview

 Read carefully any correspondence from the employer regarding date, time, location, and format of the interview.

- Do your homework...
 - Church website/livestream
 - Speak with current/former members/employees if appropriate

Preparing for the Job Interview

- Prepare a statement of purpose (from cover letter).

- Have written questions for the interviewer/committee.

- Practice for the interview just as you would for an audition.

Preparing for the Job Interview

- Dress appropriately.

- Arrive early.

- Networking (long term)

During the Interview

- Be yourself: highlight your strengths.
- Maintain eye contact and show genuine interest in the church and the position.
- Expect follow-up questions.

- Compensation (salary or per service?)

- Paid time off, vacation policy

Substitute musicians

- Sanctuary availability for organ practice/teaching
- Time of staff meetings and rehearsals
- Wedding & funeral policies, right of first refusal

- Lessons & Carols
- Christmas Eve/Christmas Day
- Ash Wednesday
- Maundy Thursday/Good Friday
- Easter Vigil
- Thanksgiving
